

## College of Agriculture and Life Sciences Outstanding Achievement in Extension Award

**Purpose:** To recognize faculty or professional staff who have demonstrated outstanding accomplishments in extension, scholarship over an extended period of time.

**Eligibility:** Members of faculty or professional staff with a minimum of 10 years service at ISU. Recipients must be ISU employees at the time of Spring Convocation.

**Nature of the award:** \$500 one-time stipend.

**Number of Awards:** One

**Criteria:** Documented evidence, including client and peer evaluations, of outstanding extension performance over an extended period of time.

### Guidelines for Submitting Nominations for Faculty Extension Award

The following guidelines are intended to help departments make their nominations as strong as possible.

1. Begin with a statement of no more than three pages describing why this person deserves the award for which he or she is being nominated. The purpose of this statement is to persuade those reviewing the nomination that your candidate is deserving of the award. Cite specific examples of relevant behaviors, publications, and recognition whenever possible.
2. Include the nominee's current curriculum vitae (limit to 4 pages).
3. Include statements from the nominee's colleagues who are in a position to comment on his or her extension programs. (4 letters maximum).

No additional materials will be considered.
