Outstanding Achievement in International Agriculture Award

PURPOSE	To recognize outstanding performance of College of Agriculture and Life Sciences faculty in promoting the globalization of research, extension, and teaching programs.
ELIGIBILITY	Must be a faculty member or a team of faculty members in the College of Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University engaged in the promotion and integration of international perspectives in research, extension, and/or teaching.
NUMBER OF AWARDS	One
NATURE OF THE AWARD	\$500 one-time stipend
CRITERIA	Documented evidence of outstanding achievement in international agriculture including one or more of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Extent to which the candidate has utilized his/her experience to globalize teaching, research and extension programs at Iowa State University.• Extent to which the candidate has demonstrated excellence in the areas of teaching, research, and/or service while engaged in international work.• Extent to which the candidate has fostered the transfer of benefits from international activities to Iowa agriculture and rural development.• Extent to which the national and international reputation of Iowa State University has been enhanced by the activity of the candidate.

Guidelines for Submitting Nominations

The following guidelines are intended to help departments make their nominations as strong as possible.

1. Begin with a statement of no more than three pages describing why this person deserves the award for which he or she is being nominated. The purpose of this statement is to persuade those reviewing the nomination that your candidate is deserving of the award. Cite specific examples of relevant behaviors, publications, and recognition whenever possible.
2. Include the nominee's current curriculum vitae (limit to 4 pages).
3. Include statements from the nominee's colleagues who are in a position to comment on his or her international activities (4 letters maximum).
