Manjit Misra is the Dean's Chair for Agriculture and Life Sciences at Iowa State University and serves as the Director of the Seed Science Center and the Founding Director of the Biosafety Institute for Genetically Modified Agricultural Products (BIGMAP). In addition, Misra is also a Professor of Agricultural and Biosystems Engineering.

Misra is a member of the Scientific Advisory Council of the American Seed Research Foundation, and is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Iowa Seed Association, the Iowa Crop Improvement Association, and the "First the Seed Foundation."

Misra earned a B.S. in Agricultural Engineering at the University of Agriculture and Technology in Orissa, India; and an M.S. in Agricultural Engineering (soil and water) and a Ph.D. in Agricultural Engineering (food and processing) at the University of Missouri-Columbia.

In addition to administration, Misra is an inventor with six U.S. patents on new technologies, and a scholar with more than 130 publications and 70 invited presentations. Misra has received many awards including the "Honorary Member Award" from the Iowa Seed Association, the "Order of the Knoll Distinguished Faculty Award" from Iowa State University, and the "Distinguished Service Award" from the American Seed Trade Association.
